## ***FURTHER HOSPITAL IMPROVEMENTS TO BEGIN AT SHHA: NO DISRUPTION TO HOSPITAL ACCESS OR SERVICES***

(Exeter, ON) – As a result of the recent ECP (Exceptional Circumstance Project) funding received by the South Huron Hospital Association (SHHA), work to install a redundant water line to SHHA will begin on Monday, August 14<sup>th</sup> in parallel with Municipality of South Huron upgrades to William Street, between Huron Street West and Anne Street.

During this time, there will be no breach of access nor disruption of services at SHHA, however, not all streets to the Hospital will be accessible. Therefore, whenever possible, the public is encouraged to utilize Huron Street West and the South Huron Medical Centre parking lot to minimize vehicular traffic and congestion around Hospital entrances.

“SHHA is proud of the improvements being made and we apologize for any inconvenience this may cause and greatly appreciate your patience and understanding,” stated Todd Stepanuik, SHHA President & CEO. He went on to add that “SHHA continues to be extremely grateful for the Ministry and South West Local Health Integration Network’s (SWLHIN) investment into SHHA.”

“It is business as usual at SHHA thanks to the Municipality of South Huron’s planning which ensured the Hospital’s quality healthcare close to home is not compromised, at any time, during the construction,” indicated Bill Brintnell, Director of Diagnostics and Operations at SHHA.

Both projects in total are estimated to run for at least 8 weeks.
