HOSPITAL IMPROVEMENTS CONTINUE AT SHHA: ACCESS TO BASEMENT LIMITED

(Exeter, ON) - As recently announced, South Huron Hospital Association (SHHA) is very fortunate to have received in excess of one million dollars in Exceptional Circumstance Project (ECP) funding from the Hospital Infrastructure Renewal Fund (HIRF) to support SHHA's ongoing advocacy for infrastructure upgrades. These funds are dedicated to specific projects to upgrade services such as heating, water services and electrical services. "As a Hospital, we continue to be extremely grateful and thank the Ministry and the South West Local Health Integration Network (SWLHIN) for their continued support of the SHHA," stated Todd Stepanuk, SHHA President & CEO.

Construction is scheduled on Thursday, November 30th and Friday, December 1st in the Hospital basement. As a result, access to the following areas will be limited:

- Thursday, November 30 – Access to and from the OneCare day program area from the main part of the basement
- Friday, December 1 - To and from the basement of the hospital via the elevator.

We have been in contact with your service providers and are collectively planning alternative access routes. Your service provider will be in contact with you should alternate access be required.
